Inclusion Alberta-students with exceptional needs, continued diligence with site-specific protocols (daily assessment, staff adhering to this, zero positive staff, ensuring that students presenting with symptoms are screened and sent home, additional adjustments-option of Google Meet for staff i.e. staff meeting, Advent is reduced to class vs. grade level cohort, continued targeted focus and daily integration of mental well-being and wellness specifically with trauma informed responsiveness through school wide mindfulness and regulation teaching and tools-daily announcements, Student Support Team, Responding to parent requests for online: In Scenario 1 from Alberta Government since Re-entry-levels of support at this time-important for parents to understand This means in school. Online was offered until September 16 If class is in quarantine: full support from classroom teacher If student is quarantined: some support from classroom teacher Parent choice to learn from home: you have access to google classroom but learning is up to parents
